Calling a Code at JBH: Dial 5555

You asked:

Q. The other day I noticed that a person fell and needed help so I ran to try to find a nurse. I didn't want to call a code because I didn't think it was a heart attack. Did I do the right thing?

A. Great Question!

If you see someone in need of Medical Assistance call ext. 5555. This will give you priority to the switchboard. Let them know there is a medical emergency and a Code Blue will be called to your location. The Code Blue team will respond and handle the situation from there. It is always best to err on the side of caution and not try to move or care for someone yourself.
